How Robin Tunney's Fall Garden Grows

Want to create a sense of space in a small, shady garden? Follow the landscaping plan that Los Angeles landscaper Cassy Aoyagi put into place in the mid-century modern home of *The Mentalist's* Robin Tunney.

"To bring depth and dimension to the small space, we layered foliage of varying size," Aoyagi says.

"And because shady spaces can make it hard to rely on flowers, we selected plants with dramatic contrasts in color. We placed variegated osmanthus, a bold plant with green and gold leaves, among the bamboo that already existed in Robin's garden. Then we added a layer of Xanadu philodendron, which has deep dark-green foliage. And, for the final bring-it-all-together touch, we added chartreuse-colored golden baby tears."



FAST Fall Fixes
